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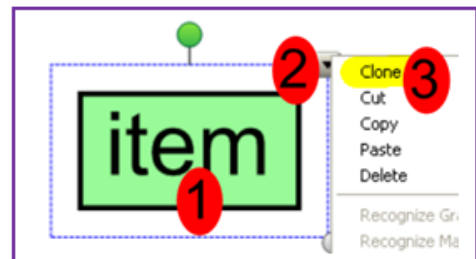
Four Corner Sorting Template A

<p>Sort the items into the correct corner.</p>	<p>Sort the items into the <u>best</u> corner.</p>	<p>Sort the items into the correct corner.</p>
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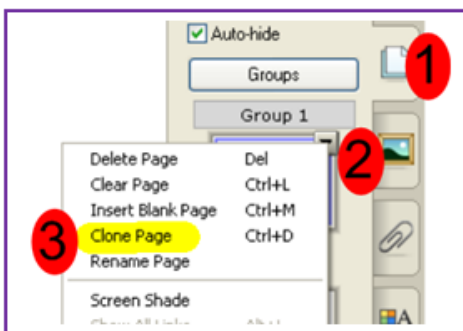
1. Double click on the corners topics to change the text.
 2. Select all the topics in the corners and lock in place.
 3. Double click on all of the items and change the text.
 4. It is nice to have at least two items in each corner.
 5. Now select all the items inside the middle and lock and allow move.
- Give think time. Pick a random student to drag an item into a corner and explain why. The next student can move a new item or change a previous item. Continue this process until all the items are placed in the corners.

Clone an item

1 Select an item. **2** Now click on the drop down dialog box that is on the upper right hand corner of the selected item. **3** Click on clone. You can also hover over an item and right click on it then click on clone. Cloning makes an exact image of what you have selected and puts it right next to the original.



Cloning is a step saver because you don't have to click on copy then paste.



Clone a page

Make sure you are viewing the page you want to clone.

1 Click on the page viewer. You will see a smaller page of the one you are currently viewing. **2** Click on the drop down dialog box on the smaller page in the page viewer. **3** Click Clone. You will now have an exact duplicate page and is useful in repeating an activity on a master slide.
